Medical Assistance Personal Care Program (MAPC)



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CLA is a certified Personal Care Agency serving children, adults and seniors in Dane and surrounding counties who have Wisconsin Medicaid and have an assessed need for help with hands on personal care at home. Personal care tasks include services such as bathing, dressing, grooming, bathroom assistance, limited housekeeping or laundry, meal preparation and nurse-delegated tasks such as mechanical lift transfers, G-tube feeding, catheter care, etc.

A Registered Nurse completes an assessment using the State of Wisconsin's Personal Care Screening Tool. This screening tool determines the services and hours authorized by the State. If eligible, services are 100 percent funded by the Medicaid program.

CLA's Role in the MA Personal Care Program:

- · Conducting initial and annual personal care needs assessments
- Recruiting Personal Care Workers or hire workers of the client's choice (applicant must pass the CLA screening process).
- Partnering with the client to train and supervise their Personal Care Workers who work for CLA

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
